1. What is Soltec Power Holdings

Soltec Power Holdings is an established group of companies operating in the renewable energy sector, particularly in the PV industry. The group, with 1.323 people employed and a 17 year long career as manufacturers of complete solar tracking systems, shows a strong commitment in innovation, developing its activity in installations located mainly in Argentina, Australia, Brasil, Chile, China, Colombia, Denmark, France, India, Israel, Italy, Kenya, Mexico, Peru, Spain and the United States. The company, founded in 2004, has a highly experienced management team.

Soltec Power Holdings involves:

- Soltec: the branch of the company in charge of the manufacture of solar trackers, offering installation and construction services, an activity that corresponds to the core business of SPH. Soltec is specialized in the development and supply of solar tracking systems.
- Powertis: the company's division in charge of the development of PV projects (Project Development). It has become an essential piece in the company's strategy, providing investors with integrated solutions in development, structuring, financing and construction of photovoltaic fields. These projects are developed with Soltec's solar trackers. Currently Powertis operates in four countries: Spain, Italy, Brazil and Denmark.





- Foundation of the company by Raúl Morales (CEO) and Francisco José Moreno
- Becoming an EPC* (Engineering, Procurement and Construction Management) and developer

- 2007: First dual-axis solar tracker and development of 20MW of solar trackers
- 2009: First single-axis tracker and first MW in Italy as EPC* (Engineering, Procurement and Construction Management)
- 2011: Solarfighter (SF) launch
- 2012: Launch of the SF selfpowered tracker

- Chile // First contract in the USA (150MW)
- 2016: 420MW supplied in Mexico and Peru // 1GW annual sales
- 2017: SF7 single axis/bifacial tracker // BoP* contracts in Spain up to 90MW // Solhub foundation
